Executive Summary:

The Police Department is presenting the following ordinance change based on a thorough review of this intersection:

The Police Department recommends signs be placed so that Banbury Avenue must yield to Independence Avenue. In addition to the yield signs, the Police Department recommends the “cross traffic” signs on Banbury Avenue be replaced with current signs stating “Cross Traffic Does Not Stop”. Once installed, all signs on Banbury Avenue, the yield signs, and “Cross Traffic Does Not Stop” signs, need to have flags added to draw attention to the new signs and changes.

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-M-_____

An Ordinance amending title 10 "Vehicles and Traffic", Section 10.11 "Rules of the Road" of the St. Charles Municipal Code

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: That Title 10 "Vehicles and Traffic", Section 10.11 "Rules of the Road", of the St. Charles Municipal Code, is hereby deleted in its entirety and in lieu thereof the following language shall be substituted:

“10.11 Rules of the Road

10.11.2100 Intersections where stop or yield required. (B) 10

On Banbury Avenue at its intersection with Independence Avenue so that east and westbound traffic on Banbury Avenue must yield to traffic on Independence Avenue.”

SECTION TWO: That, after the adoption and approval hereof, this Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the City Council of the City of St. Charles, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days from and after its passage by a vote of the majority of the corporate authorities now holding office, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.
