We have made a series of presentations to various committees over the last three public meetings. We are now ready to formally adopt the City's budget fore

FY 2012/13. We have done all things necessary to legally adopt the budget. Staff recommends approval.

- Mayor DeWitte
  - I just want to thank everyone on both sides of the room here. The Staff table and the City Council. The last three to four years have been difficult, not only in the City of St. Charles but in the country. I am pleased and proud to be working with a group of people on both sides here that have not been afraid to make the difficult decisions we have had to make over the years.   - This item is a housekeeping item. It is essentially a resolution put in place to make sure that if the expenditures that we incur for the Red Gate road bridge project come in advance of the issuance of the bonds. That we have tied up all the loose ends from an IRS regulation standpoint to be able to reimburse the City from the proceeds of that particular bond issue. It is important to note this does not change any of the amounts, grant revenues, total cost of the project or any of the specifics. It is simply a matter of timing. The timing for the bond issue might not line up with the timing of the expenditures because we are trying to roll in the bond issue and the bonds for the EAV that was discussed last week. We want to make sure we get everything tied up. Again, this is just a safeguard that we are covered from an IRS standpoint.
