6. Additional Business:

- 6a) Chairman Smunt advised the Commission of his plans to reroof his house located at 403 S. 6th St. He is considering changing the design of the shingles from rectangle to octagon cut style. Ridge vents will be used with gutters to be half round aluminum. The work may not happen until Spring 2013. A round table discussion took place on the shingle type and installation method.
- 6b) Mr. Prestidge noted that window replacements were approved at a previous meeting, but he asked if the COA included chimney replacement. He noted the brick has been removed and it is now a framed wooden chimney and it looks like the owner is getting ready to side it. The Commission indicated that the chimney replacement was not part of the COA. The Commission viewed a picture of the house to see the chimney. Mr. Colby will follow-up with Building and Code Enforcement.

Chairman Smunt recommends that if anyone has a concern with work going on in the Historic District, contact Mr. Colby as he has access to the permit records.
