In addition, Public Works was to investigate possible striping changes to assist with the traffic management. Pre-construction (April 9 – 13, 2012): 1100 block eastbound ADT 1,433, average speed 28 mph, 85% 33 mph. westbound the ADT was 1,471, average speed 32 mph, 85% 37 mph. February 4 – 6, 2013: 900 block eastbound ADT 1,970, average speed 25 mph, 85% 29.8 mph. westbound the ADT was 1,516, average speed 25 mph, 85% 30.9 mph. February 13 – 15, 2013: 1500 block eastbound ADT 1,543, average speed 27 mph, 85% 30.5 mph. westbound the ADT was 2,305, average speed 25 mph, 85% 29.4 mph. These counts were all conducted on clear days. Engineering has also completed draft alternative traffic management plans for the intersection of Madison Avenue /Tyler Road. **Attachments:** (please list)





ON MADISON AVENUE AT TYLER ROAD




