Executive Summary:

At the Planning & Development meeting on August 11 the committee recommended approval for funding the subject celebration. This approval was contingent on oversight through the City Administrator's office that would include but not be limited to 1) an application update from a not-for-profit, 501(C)3 organization (the Daughters of the American Revolution was offered by the applicant's representative), 2) the City's contribution would be in a reimbursement to the applicant for documented expenses consistent with the request, and 2) an amount not to exceed \$1000.

Again, Kim Malay was requesting funding to support the planned re-dedication for Camp Kane and the Jones Law Office relocation planned for September 20, 2014. Planning & Development Committee recommended approval to City Council.
