EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Proposed is the installation of two wall signs for The Bend General Store.

The front sign material is high density urethane with raised lettering. Three gooseneck lights will be installed to illuminate the sign.

The same sign design on an flat aluminum panel will be installed on the rear of the building facing the parking lot.

RECOMMENDATION / SUGGESTED ACTION:

Provide feedback and recommendations on approval of the COA.



48" tall x 94" wide x 1.5" thick sandblasted HDU (high density urethane) panel - raised border, letters and logo area. Red background area blasted into panel with a pebble finish. Logo graphic section would be vinyl decal due to complexity.




Sign will be screwed directly to the brick with Tap-Con concrete screws.

3 Gooseneck lights will be added by Dupage Lighting - Wes Scroggin. Tying into existing electrical that is on a timer.
