EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Commission discussed and tabled this item on 9/3/14. The Commission expressed concern that some of the work had already been completed. The applicant will be present to provide additional information.

Simmons Insurance Agency has requested a Façade Improvement Grant to assist with funding the reconstruction an existing front porch that is deteriorated.

The cost of the work is estimated at \$7,200 and the grant would cover up to \$3,600.

This building previously received a façade grant in 2009-2010 for repainting and re-roofing the building and garage, repair of the garage building and installation of a new doors and a cupola, and installation of a retaining wall. The property received a grant in 1999 for repairs to the front porch, including new decking.



The improvements are as follows:

New frame work under the porch to level porch

New floor which looks just like wood. Has a 10 year warranty against fading. A sample is enclosed.

New railing made from the same 10 year material.

Total cost of work is estimated to be \$6500 to \$7200.


