Executive Summary:

As the 7th Avenue Creek Project continues to move forward, there are a few key updates that we would like to discuss tonight as it relates to the FEMA Mapping Update Process and the City of St. Charles Study Process.

FEMA Mapping Update Process

It was originally anticipated that FEMA would be presenting the City with the proposed draft floodplain maps for review and holding public meeting in April/May 2015. We were recently notified by FEMA that there is a delay on their end due to new design and review regulations. They are not anticipating the release of the draft maps and public meeting sometime in July 2015.

City of St. Charles Study Process

The City’s consultant HR Green continues to move forward with the evaluation of potential design options to develop a long term master plan to relieve flooding along the 7th Avenue Creek watershed. In addition, HR Green received the hydraulic modeling information from FEMA and they are working to identify any areas of concern so we can provide comments back to FEMA for their evaluation.

In an effort to keep everyone informed of the change in the project schedule we are working to provide additional information to the property owners, residents and businesses in the area by the following means:

- **Project Website** - Updating the project website with the anticipated FEMA dates.
- **Email Blast** - Sending out an email blast to those who have signed up through the City’s website.
- **Letters** – Sending out letters notifying every one of the updates to the project schedule.
