Executive Summary:

On Saturday, August 29 and Sunday, August 30, 2015, the Veterans Wishes/Jack Axe Games event will be held at the Kane County Fairgrounds.

Alley 64 Bar and Grill has applied for an E-2 license to serve alcohol at the event. Only beer will be served, and it will be contained inside a tent area. Minors will not be allowed in the area; wrist bands will be provided for those who are 21 and over; food will be provided through Buona Beef and The River House Barbecue; BASSET certificates have been provided.

Beer will be served from 5:00 pm to 10:00 pm each day. Two police officers shall be assigned to this event through extra duty reimbursement.

This item was brought before the Liquor Control Commission earlier today for recommendation of a Class E2 liquor license for Alley 64 Bar and Grill for this event at the Kane County Fairgrounds located at 525 S Randall Road. Due to receiving this request in short notice and to meet the deadline for approval, upon the decision of the Liquor Control Commission meeting, Mayor Rogina will present those findings and will ask for Council approval of this request.

- The Class E2 license fee is \$100.00 per day.
- A minimum of three (3) liquor supervisors shall monitor liquor service during all times of operation. **Please provide a list of all supervisors with this application.**
- Beer and/or Wine are the only alcoholic beverages to be sold.
- Hours are restricted to 12 noon to 12:00 midnight.
- Licensee must rope/fence off the licensed premises.
- Each patron must wear a wristband after having identification checked for legal alcohol consumption age.
- Are children/minors permitted in the licensed premises? YN
- A sign limited beer and/or wine consumption to the roped off area must be conspicuously displayed at all times.
- Each server of alcohol must be BASSET certified - need copy of BASSET certification.**
- A copy of site plan diagram to include roped area shall accompany this application.
- All security/police resources needed shall be attached to this application with approval of the Chief of Police before final issuance by Liquor Commissioner.




PRIMARY BEER AREA
