
## NATIONAL POLICE WEEK

- WHEREAS,** there are approximately 900,000 law enforcement officers serving in communities across the United States, including the dedicated members of the St. Charles Police Department;
- WHEREAS,** nearly 60,000 assaults against law enforcement officers are reported each year, resulting in approximately 16,000 injuries;
- WHEREAS,** since the first recorded death in 1791, over 20,000 law enforcement officers in the United States have made the ultimate sacrifice and been killed in the line of duty, including one member of the St. Charles Police Department;
- WHEREAS,** it is known that 126 officers across the Nation gave their lives in the performance of their duties in 2014 – a 24% increase from 2013. The names of 286 fallen law enforcement heroes were added to the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial in Washington, D. C. in 2014;
- WHEREAS,** the City of St. Charles desires to honor the valor, service, and dedication of its own police officers, and to join the countless communities and cities across the nation to honor police officers everywhere.

**NOW, THEREFORE** I, Raymond Rogina, Mayor of the City of St. Charles, Illinois do hereby proclaim the week of **May 10<sup>th</sup> to the 16<sup>th</sup>, 2015** to be **NATIONAL POLICE WEEK** and **May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2015** to be **NATIONAL PEACE OFFICERS MEMORIAL DAY**. I call upon our citizens in this community to especially honor and show our sincere appreciation for the police officers of the city by deed, remark, and attitude. I call upon all of our citizens to make every effort to express their thanks to our men and women who make it possible for us to leave our homes and family in safety each day, and to return to our homes knowing they are protected by police officers who are willing to sacrifice their lives if necessary to guard our loved ones, our property and our government against all who would violate the law.

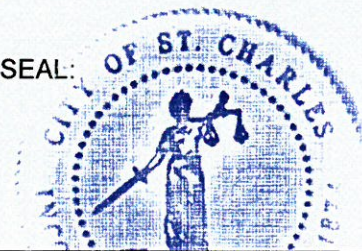


## EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES WEEK

## **Fr. David Peck**

### **Short Biography**

Born Aurora, Fr. David Peck attended Immaculate Heart Central High School in Watertown, NY, DeSales University followed by a year of study at Universidad de Javaiana in Bogota, Columbia. He studied theology at Catholic University for a couple of years, and then spent 10 years in business and post-graduate work at New York University. He completed his master of divinity degree at St. Mary-of-the-Lake Seminary in Mundelein in 1994.

He was ordained to the priesthood by Bishop Arthur J. O'Neill on May 21, 1994.

From 1994-1998 Fr. Peck was an associate at St. Mary Church in Elgin, and then at St. Patrick, St. Charles. He also served at St. Edward Catholic High School in many progressive roles from teacher and coach to principal and superintendent. In July 1998 he became secretary to Bishop Thomas G. Doran and Diocesan Master of Ceremonies. Later that year he became Diocesan Director of Pilgrimages and the following year Director of the Pro-Life Office for the diocese.

He became pastor of St. Patrick Parish in Rochelle, IL in October 2000 and then in July 2011 he became pastor of St. Rita Parish in Rockford. While at St. Rita's he was appointed by Bishop David Malloy and served as Dean of the Rockford Deanery. He was also appointed Parochial Administrator of St. Edward Parish in Rockford, IL.

In 2013 Fr. Peck became pastor of St. John Neumann, St. Charles. He was a board member of Priest Wellness and he continues to serve as a spiritual director to priests and deacons. Since 2014 he has served on the Rockford Diocese Presbyterial Council and Clergy Relief boards. Since taking on new responsibilities for the diocese, Fr. Peck is no longer the Diocesan Director of Pilgrimages however he continues to lead annual pilgrimages abroad.

Fr. Peck enjoys serving in the parish, diocese and community at large. In 2014/15 school year he has served on the Growth in District 303 Committee, and he was also a part of updating the 2014 Strategic Plan via focus group discussion.
