SAFE PRACTICES

- Do you keep a list of valuable property?
- Do you have a list of serial numbers of your electronics, lawn care equipment and similar items?
- Do you have a description (including cost)
 and photos of valuables, including jewelry?
- Do you keep your garage door closed and keep valuables out of view from the outside?
- Do you keep excess cash and other valuables in a secure safe or bank?
- Do you hide a house key under a doormat or elsewhere?
- Does your family know what to do if they discover
 a burglar attempting to break in, or already in the house?
- Does your family know to leave the house undisturbed and call911 if they discover a burglary has been committed?
- Do you keep your doors locked at all times, even when you are in the house?



EXTERIOR

- Are shrubs/bushes within 4 feet of any sidewalk, driveways,
 doors or gates maintained at a height of not more than 2 feet?
- Are ground plants under windows maintained at a height that is below the window sill?
- Are trees trimmed so that lower branches are more than 6 feet off the ground?
- Are lights installed around the perimeter of your house?
- Do you leave lights on in the front and rear of your house at night?
 Do they shine on doors?
- Is your house number illuminated or easily visible from the street during all hours?
- Have you limited access to the second story and roof by properly storing ladders, and avoiding climbable trellises and drainpipes?
- Do you keep side gates locked?
- Are there hiding places near doors, windows, garages or parking areas?

DOORS AND ENTRY AREAS

- Are your exterior doors of solid-core construction?
- Do exterior doors have a cylinder-type deadbolt lock with at least a
 1-inch throw?
- Are the door strike plates and hinges installed with 3-inch screws?
- Do the doors without cylinder locks have a heavy bolt or similar
 secure device that can be operated only from the inside?
- Can all of your doors be securely locked?



Doors and Entry Areas, continued

- Are you locks in good operating condition?
- Are locks that can be opened from the inside at least
 40 inches from side glass?
- Are entry areas unobstructed by shrubs and other décor to permit maximum visibility?
- Do sliding doors have an auxiliary lock that locks both panels, or do you
 have a bar or similar device?
- Do exterior lights have a minimum 60-watt light bulb?
- Do you lock your garage door when it's not in use?
- Is the garage door secured with a padlock, hasp or other good auxiliary lock, and can it be locked from both sides?
- Do you lock your car and take the keys out even when it is parked in a locked garage?
- Do you know everyone who has a key to your house?

Windows

- Are all windows equipped with auxiliary locks or pins, and are the locks properly and securely mounted?
- Do you keep windows locked with they are shut?
- Do you use locks that allows you to lock a window that is partially open?
- Do you have good, secure locks on garage windows?
- Do you have garage windows covered?



GOING ON A TRIP

Do you arrange for neighbors, friends or family to pick up newspapers,
 mail and/or packages? Or do you stop delivery of these items?

- Do you notify a neighbor that you'll be gone?
- Do you leave some window treatments open
 (without creating too much visibility) so the house looks occupied?
- Do you arrange to keep your lawn maintained?
- If you go on vacation in the winter do you arrange to have snow plowed?
- Do you have timers on your lamps and exterior lights?
- Do you test your smoke and burglar alarms?
